

## Revised diagnostic criteria for Fraser syndrome

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### Major criteria

- Syndactyly
- Cryptophthalmos spectrum
- Urinary tract abnormalities
- Ambiguous genitalia
- Laryngeal and tracheal anomalies
- Positive family history

### Minor criteria

- Anorectal defects
- Dysplastic ears
- Skull ossification defects
- Umbilical abnormalities
- Nasal anomalies

### Diagnosis of Fraser syndrome

3 major criteria  
OR  
2 major and 2 minor criteria  
OR  
1 major and 3 minor criteria
