

## **Dutch Neuromuscular Database CRAMP - Computer Registry of All Myopathies and Polyneuropathies**

CRAMP was developed in 2004 by the Dutch Neuromuscular Research Support Centre, to store information on patient characteristics and diagnoses (based on Rowland and McLeod's classification) in a uniform and easily retrievable manner. In contrast to most other registries, here all known neuromuscular disorders are eligible for registration, including if a specific diagnosis is unavailable. In that case, a patient can be entered based on his/her symptoms.
